Local area



Osuna is the closest town to Park Las Vistas

Osuna extends along the slope of a small hill and allows the town to keep watch over the extensive fields of olive trees and cereals in the Seville countryside. There are many monuments and artistic works reflecting the area's long history. Examples of this are the "Osuna Reliefs" which are Turtedani pieces from archaeological sites in this area, which are kept in the National Archaeological Museum in Madrid.



The town also had great importance during the Roman Empire, as can be seen in the "Osuna Bronzes", a compilation of laws which can also be seen in the same museum.

Among famous people associated with Osuna is Juan de Ayala, the commander of the first European ship to enter the San Francisco Bay in California. The battle of Munda, the last battle won by Julius Caesar in person, was thought to be fought outside of Osuna, halfway to Écija near La Lantejuela. In Michelangelo Antonioni's film, The Passenger, the character of Locke (played by Jack Nicholson) is assassinated in a hotel located in Osuna (Hotel de la Gloria).
